SOLAR-POWERED LED LIDLIGHT

Simply Brilliant's LidLight—a light that mounts inside a locker or dock storage box—appears to take energy efficiency to a new level. Not only does the unit employ five super-bright LEDs and an NiMH rechargeable battery, but it also uses a 1,000-cycle waterproof solar panel that reportedly provides sufficient charge for up to four hours of continuous light. A tilt switch turns the light on only when the lid opens. The manufacturer advertises the product as “wireless,” which means in this case that no wiring is required for installation. You'll still have to cut a 1 3/4" hole in the lid or hatch to connect the light to its solar charger. \$39.95. **Simply Brilliant LLC**; 888-557-6464; www.sollight.com
