AVOID THE DARK

With the RailLight (\$28) from Simply Brilliant (888/557-6464; simplybrilliant.biz), you'll never have to worry about being left in the dark. This stainless steel, solar-powered LED contains a built-in sensor that automatically turns the light off in daylight and on at night.

The RailLight promises to shed eight hours worth of light with a full charge of sunlight, but it also comes with a protected, manual switch if

you prefer darkness. The Transom Clamp, included with the RailLight, adjusts up to 2 inches and can be clamped onto jon-boats and canoes, or toerails and cockpit coaming for safety, work or visibility purposes. Best of all, this portable light source will even float if it's accidentally dropped in the water.

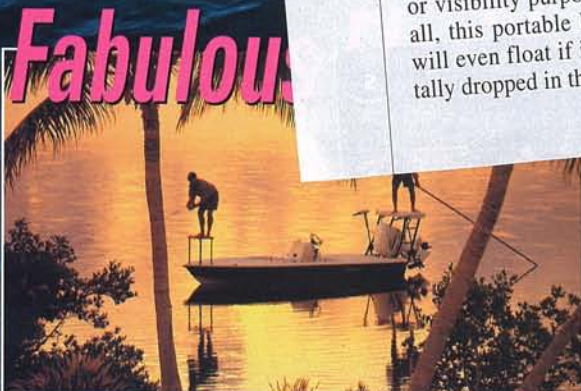
